The fascists have already declared war upon the people. Will the people as a whole rise up to meet this challenge with a righteous People's War against these fascist pigs, or will Black people have to go it alone, thus transforming a dream of interracial solidarity into the nightmare of a Race War?

Our brothers are being murdered in their sleep by the shock troopers of the power structure; our offices are being subjected to all-out military attack; our lawyers are being sentenced to prison along with us; and the fascist Nixon Administration has unleashed the political police of the F.B.I. and thrown away all pretenses of justice and equality under the law. Lip-service to the Constitution of the United States of America has been replaced by outright fascist terror and naked repression. Hundreds of our Party members have been jacked-up on highly political charges. Scores of our Party members languish in jails and prisons, subjected to scandalously high bails that are tantamount to RANSOM, Throughout the length and breath of this depraved land, the situation is the same. It is nothing

but an attempt to sabotage the 400 year struggle of our people for freedom and liberation.

Our Minister of Defense, Huey P. As time goes by, I think it will become very clear to people in general that the coming of Huey Newton and the founding of the Black Panther Party by him and Bobby Seale was truly an historic event. Because you almost have to start dealing with religious categories to talk about the importance of what they did. It must always be kept in mind that of Huey and Bobby, Huey is/was the dynamo, the source, the prime mover. And it was he who set the standard by which Black men from that point on will be measured by themselves, by Black men and by Black women. In this sense, it doesn't really matter how White people judge Huey or whather or not they understand why he is so important to us. The important thing is the profound effect that he has had in elevating the consciousness of Black people inside the United States. It is very clear also that Huey's influence has spread beyond Black people, and that there are many young White people who relate charismatically to Huey Newton. But Huey has charisma for the average young Black cat and definitely has charisma for young Black women. Huey was able to influence people who have never been influenced in the history of the United States. Huey was able to take the dispossessed and forgotten element--we call them the "brothers and sisters off the block", those who live in the urban ghettos and who are not represented by any organization, any political machinery. Huey was able to take winos and dope fiends, thieves, pimps and to politicize them and give them the motivation and the discipline to participate in organized political activity. This was a fantastic achievement. The closest that anyone ever came to that in the past was Elijah Muhammed and the Black Muslim Movement. Through the voice of Malcolm X, the Black Muslims were able to reach some of the same people. The people whom Huey Newton was able to reach are the people who listened to Malcolm X. The people who would listen to Malcolm X but who wouldn't join his organization but who listened to him sympathetically. Huey was able to strike a fire in their hearts and to infuse them with an enthusiasm that was miraculous. But you could understand that and how that could be done when you see Huey in action on the scene of oppression, when you see a scene go down, the type of scene that Black people have been subjected to for centuries. I'm speak-

ing of confrontations that speak of death. Scenes where some Black person has just been brutalized by a cop or as in Richmond, California, April, 1967, when the police killed, in the most vicious manner, Denzil Dowell, a young Black man; and whose mother was upset and demanding an investigation.

Her son had been murdered in the most blatant and vicious manner shot down in an alley with a shotgun by pigs. And this mother was very upset as we can understand and all she wanted was an investigation. She wanted something to be done about it and she went to the authorities and asked the authorities to have a Grand Jury investigation. The Coroner rushed through his investigation and called it justifiable homicide. And here was this mother with a huge family, I think about fourteen people in her family, a very poor woman, a woman who was ill, a woman who had been more or less robbed by life years ago and whose only perspective was to see her children, all finally grow up and do the best that they could. And Denzil Dowell was kind of the jewel of the family. I'm not that they would all have gotten away sure whether or not he was the baby from that scene, and gotten away from of the family but his mother was very, very fond of him because he was the firmly holding them together. one in the family whom she could rely on, to whom she could turn and ask to do things, to run errands for her when other people didn't seem to be available. Denzil Dowell was her right hand and he had gone out of the house to do something for her and he never came back. Someone came to her house and told her that the police had just killed her son. She was in hysterics almost. She was hysterical for justice. She put out this call to all the Black organizations to come and talk to her, to have a meeting at her home so that something could be done about the murder of her son. She asked for the NAACP, the Urban League, and CORE, and some of the religious organizations just to come and discuss this with her because she was not well enough to go and visit all of them. And she asked them to send a representative and she didn't even know about the Black Panther Party. But at the moment, the time that was set aside for this meeting, we showed up, the Black Panther Party showed up, and none of see sitting in the front rower pew of

And it was around this incident, trying to do something for Mrs. Dowell, that I really became convinced that I

had to join the Black Panther Party. That's the moment when it was clear to me that I was a Black Panther, I had been associating with the Panthers and I had been strongly attracted to the Panthers but out of this attempt to get this investigation, there were many... times when I saw Huey step forward, under the gwns of the police, in a very fearless manner. Not for money; not for any compensation of that type, but out of the desire to do something for his people. To see Huey Newton step forward confront murderous, brutal, vicious gestapo pigs and to see him do this fearlessly and to hear him articulate the grievances of his people and to hear him hurl forth an implacable demand for alleviation of these grievances, it was a thing that has to be seen in a certain perspective and in a certain context. If you can understand that then you can understand why and how Huey P. Newton was able to get other Black men and women to pick up the gun and stand with him in defense of our people.

When Huey was on the streets out of jail, he was always in a hurry. Huey walked fast, he talked fast, in everything he did there was a sense of urgency about it, because he knew that time was very short for him. He fully expected to be shot down some night, to be killed by pigs. During those days it was like walking on egg shells, egg shells that were filled with explosives. Tension, tension was extremely high within the group, and every moment was like the last moment. And no one would have been able to hold his cool unless Huey held his. I always got the impression that when there would be a group of Panthers together, they were ready to split and each other, but for Huey standing there

At this particular time that I was trying to talk about when we were in Richmond, we visited the scene where Denzil Dowell was shot down in this alley. And there were about thirteen or fourteen members of the Black Panther Party there all of whom were armed except myself, I didn't have a gun. And when the cops found out that we were there with guns, well just reacting as they have always reacted in the past, they dispatched their troops to the scene. And there were maybe fifteen or twenty people from the community, Black people who knew Denzil Dowell and who were concerned about Denzil Dowell, and Denzil Dowell's mother was there. You have to picture this elderly Black woman, In describing Denzil Dowell's mother you have to picture an elderly stout woman; a woman recognized by other people in the community as being a mother, a grandmother; an elderly woman who had the appearance of being weary and tired; the type of women you might the other organizations showed up, a Baptist church on any given Sunday. We are taught at an early age that the term "democracy" means "rule of the people." But what we are not taught is that there are basically two kinds of demo- kind of democracy: Proletarian cracy---bourgeoisie democracy and proletarian democracy. So now we are left with the question, "A democracy for whom? Let us take a closer look at this word democracy and apply it to our present-day society,

When the word democracy is used in our presence, many of us immediately think of an imposing building which we have been taught to call "the House of Congress, or in some cases, "the House of Parliament' Inside this huge building, we visualize two socalled opposing groups of men, one group being the "majority power" and the other group jocking for position to become the majority power at the next general election. But this, of course, is only the machinery of a certain kind of democracy. It does not relate to the essense of what a true democracy is. The essense of a true democracy is simply a government by the people, of the people and for the people and the assurance that the representatives of the people will be freely elected by the people. Hot then we are told that the two opposing groups of men in that contressional building are the elected representatives of the people; this would include also the President of the State, who is not a member of Congress but does have the power to veto any of the laws passed by Congress, and the power to declare or stop a war.

And the representatives of the people -- the people, or the demos, now being the proletarian class -- are, of course, elected to serve the proletarian, being that they (the representatives) are from the majority class. The lynching was the first in the nation in hearly a year and was the first mulitple lynching since two 14-year-old Negro Doys were hanged by a Mississippi mob in October, 1942. For Georgia it was the first lynching of more than one person since 1918 when ten Negroes. were lynched in Brooks County.

to ask: "What is the country going to do for me?" The capitalist blood suckers have been running a game on the masses that must stop and one sure way to stop these vultures is for the masses to rise up and seize power, destroying everything in their way.



CHICAGO PIGS FOUND GUILTY OF MURDER, BY PEOPLE'S INQUEST

Bobby Rush, deputy defense minister of the Illinois Black Panther Party, yesterday told the Daily Defender that the Panther Party will exhaust all means necessary to have the attempted murder charges against the survivors of the Fred Hampton apartment raid drop-

Rush also indicated there may be possible court action in implementing their demand for murder indictments against States Attorney Edward Hanrahan, his assistant Richard Jalovec, and the 14 policemen involved in the slayings of Hampton and Mark Clark last Decem-

The purpose of obtaining such an indictment would be "to make those pigs in the power structure responsive and realize they must answer to the people. They must be made to realize they aren't some clique who are above the people," Rush said. He made the state-ment Monday as a follow-up of a "peoples inquest" into the deaths of Hampton and Clark, which was held last Sunday at the First Congregational Church on 40 N. Ashland.

At that time, a "peoples jury" indicted Hanrahan, Jalovee and the 14 policemen on murder charges, and demanded the charges against the raid's seven survivors be dropped.

More than 800 people attended the inquest which was called by the Panther Party, and the Emergency Conference to Defend the Right of the Black Panther Party to Exist.

Rush chaired the proceedings. Dr. Charles G. Hurst, president of Malcolm X College, acted as "coroner" during the inquest, and Panther secretary Jewel Cook was the prosecutor.

The jury was composed of six representatives of the bi-racial emergency conference and six members of the black community,

Dr. Hurst told the assembly, that "The Black Panther Party has been maligned in every way. The inquest grew out of the response of the community itself to the verdict of "justifiable homicide" ruled by the official coroner's inquest. By any means necessary, we will bring justice to this country."

The inquest began with the film of the police re-enactment of the raid. The seven survivors were then called upon to testify as witnesses. Though all were present, Louis Truelock was unable to testify due to filness.

The seven did not testify at the official in-

came when Debra Johnson, Hampton's girifriend, who was nine months pregnant at the time of the raid, gave her testimony. "I came home that night after a political orientation class," said Miss Johnson. "Later on someone came in the room and started shaking the chairman. We woke up and saw shots being fired. He (Hampton) looked up and then he laid his head back down. I assume ne was shot then. They kept shooting."

Miss Johnson at this point paused for several seconds in an attempt to regain her composure. She went on to relate how she was pushed into the kitchen where she said she overheard a policeman remark, "He's good

The most dramatic moment of the event

They put us in a paddy wagon. A pig grabbed me by the arm and jabbed a gun in my stomach saying you'd better not try to escape. I was wondering how I was going to escape with pigs everywhere with guns."

The five remaining witnesses who testified gave essentially the same account of what happened in the apartment.

Brenda H rris said, "I went to sleep in the front room. The next time I woke up I heard a knock on the door. Clark said 'Just a minute'. Next thing I know they broke down the door. They shot me. They shot Clark.

"A guy with a machine gun started spraying the walls. I heard somebody say "There's some more in the back." They went over to see if I w.s dead. They looked disappointed that I wasn't.

"They started calling me all kinds of bitches and whores - that I had no right to live and that I should be dead anyway: They kept threatening me and telling me to die. I could hear how they were beating and eursing peaple in the back.

Ronald (Doc) Satchel, said he was asleep in the first bedroom when he heard a knock on the door. "Very shortly afterward I heard shots." He described how he woke the other two people in the next bed and told them to get on the floor. Bullets were coming into the room through the wall."

According to Satchel, the policemen ordered him to walk out of the room and made him walk to the ambulance even though he told them he was wounded. He was shot twice in the stomach, once in the leg and in each hand.

Verlina Brewer, wounded in the leg, said she must still wear her cast for two more months and that she would probably be required to wear some kind of brace permanently. She told the assembly that she began to slip off the stretcher as she was being carried out of the apartment. She said a policeman said "Watch it, she's slipping off." To which another policeman replied, "It don't matter."

When she fell off, she charged she was thrown back on the stretcher and "They slammed the ambulance door on my wounded leg."

Blair Anderson and Harold Bell corroborated the stories of the previous witnesses and gave further testimony of alleged police brutality. Anderson, who was wounded in the groin said a policeman told him, "all you M F S should be dead." That little black pig (officer Davis) was just standing there with a gun in his hand grinning.

Harold Bell testified that his first thought, when he heard the shooting, was to wake Hampton, "As I was turning to the room they were coming in the back door. I couldn't wake Fred Hampton. One was shooting with a service revolver, and another with a shotgun.

He said he overheard a policeman say later at the police station, "You can't kill a revolution, but you can kill a revolutionary."

He stated that he thought the defendant was going to attack the alleged victim because she attempted to open the car door of his (Hess') vehicle (R.T. 36), But clearly defendant could have had any number of reasons, including the need to rest herself, while she waited patiently for the police - making no attempt whatsoever to leave the scene - (R.T. 36) other than that denied having told the police that the alleged victim was drunk and disorderly until actually shown his statement; at which time he admitted it (R.T. 312). 

The magistrate denied the defendant due process of law by erroneously granting a continuance in violation of the statute; prejudicially limiting cross-examination, There is a fatal variance between the alleged victim charged and the alleged victim produced at the hearing - at which time even this alleged victim denied having been assaulted. No one saw the defendant hit anyone, use any force, or threaten anyone with a deadly weapon. The information should be dismissed.

RULES OF THE BLACK PANTHER PARTY

NATIONAL HEADQUARTERS BERKELEY, CALIFORNIA

Every member of the BLACK PANTHER PARTY throughout this country of racist America must abide by these rules as functional members of this party. CENTRAL COMMITTEE members, CENTRAL STAFFS, and LOCAL STAFFS, including all captains subordinate to either national, state, and local leadership of the BLACK PANTHER PARTY will enforce these rules. Length of suspension or other disciplinary action necessary for violation of these rules will depend on national decisions by national, state or state area, and local committees and staffs where said rule or rules of the BLACK PANTHER PARTY WERE VIOLATED.

Every member of the party must know these verhatum by heart, and apply them daily. Each member must report any violation of these rules to their leadership or they are counter-revolutionary and are also subjected to suspension by the BLACK PANTHER PARTY.

THE RULES ARE:

- No party member can have narcotics or weed in his possession while doing party work.
- Any party member found shooting narcotics will be expelled from this party.
 No party member can be DRUNK while doing daily party work.
- 4. No party member will violate rules relating to office work, general meetings of the BLACK PANTHER PARTY, and meetings of the BLACK PANTHER PARTY ANYWHERE.
- No party member will USE, POINT, or FIRE a weapon of any kind unnecessarily or accidentally at anyone.
- 6. No party member can join any other army force other than the BLACK LIBERATION ARMY.

 7. No party member can have a weapon in his possession while
- 7. No party member can have a weapon in his possession while DRUNK or loaded off narcotics or weed.

 8. No party member will commit any crimes against other party
- members or BLACK people at all, and cannot steal or take from the people, not even a needle or a piece of thread.

 9. When arrested BLACK PANTHER MEMBERS will give only
- name, address, and will sign nothing. Legal first aid must be understood by all Party members. 10. The Ten Point Program and platform of the BLACK PANTHER
- PARTY must be known and understood by each Party member.

 11. Party Communications must be National and Local.

 12. The 10-10-10-program should be known by all members and
- also understood by all members.
 13. All Finance officers will operate under the jurisdiction of the Ministry of Finance.
- Each Sub-Section Leader Section Leader, Lieutenant, and Captain must submit Daily reports of work.

14. Fach person will submit a report of daily work.

- 16. All Panthers must learn to operate and service weapons correctly.
 17. All Leadership personnel who expel a member must submit this information to the Editor of the Newspaper, so that it will be published.
- in the paper and will be known by all chapters and branches.

 18. Political Education Classes are mandatory for general membership.
- 19. Only office personnel assigned to respective offices each day should be there. All others are to sell papers and do Political work out in the community, including Captains, Section Leaders, etc.



TRIAL OF BARRY FARMER, JAMES CHERRY & CLYDE BURTON

On February 20th, 1970 the pigs of the atlantic city police force attempted to railroad three of the people's warriors in a racist court.

We arrived in court at about 9:15 after serving the children of our community their free breakfast before school, as we sat in the courtroom, we saw one person after another being railroaded through the halls of injustice. It was plain to see that the courtroom was really a mockery of justice.

Clyde Burton, James Cherry, and Barry Farmer were arrested on the fabricated charge of creating disorder in a public building when Clyde's brother, Eric Burton, was arrested, beaten, and kidnapped off the streets. They saved the case until almost everyone else had gone. This showed that they had every intention of railroading the brothers. But about 50 beautiful brothers and sisters stayed to support them and show how determined they were to see Clyde, James, and Barry free.

The case started with one pig's story which was contradictory to a second pig's story; the pigs were worried and confused. So they called a time out, to get their lies together. But it was too late, because the people saw the contradictions and were determined to

see justice done. Even after the pigs were clearly proven to be liars, Judge (Pig) Perone charged Clyde Burton, James Cherry, and Barry Farmer with "defacing public property", because they had written ALL POWER TO THE PEOPLE on the jail cells. Contradictions rose and the people were getting mad and let the pigs know that they were wrong. Reinforcements were brought in

and pretty soon the court was half

filled with pigs. The whole thing was a beautiful political education class and clearly pointed out the contradictions between justice and injustice. When Bobby Seale layed down that righteous example he showed clearly that there will be no justice for Black people in the fascist courts of Babylon, as long as this oppressive system of capitalism and racism continues to stand ...







What We Want What We Believe



Huey P. Newton Minister of Defense Black Panther Party

1. We want freedom. We want power to determine the destiny of our Black Community.

We believe that black people will not be free until we are able to determine our destiny.

2. We want full employment for our people.

We believe that the federal government is responsible and obligated to give every man employment or a guaranteed income. We believe that if the white American businessmen will not give full employment, then the means of production should be taken from the businessmen and placed in the community so that the people of the community can organize and employ all of its people and give a high standard of living.

3. We want an end to the robbery by the CAPITALIST of our Black Community.

We believe that this racist government has robbed us and now we are demanding the overdue debt of forty acres and two mules. Forty acres and two mules was promised 100 years ago as restitution for slave labor and mass murder of black people. We will accept the payment in currency which will be distributed to our many communities. The Germans are now aiding the Jews in Israel for the genocide of the Jewish people. The Germans murdered six million Jews. The American racist has taken part in the slaughter of over fifty million black people; therefore, we feel that this is a modest demand that we make.

4. We want decent housing. fit for shelter of human beings.

We believe that if the white landlords will not give decent housing to our black community, then the housing and the land should be made into cooperatives so that our community, with government aid, can build and make decent housing for its people.

We want education for our people that exposes the true nature of this decadent American society. We want education that teaches us our true history and our role in the present-day society.

We believe in an educational system that will give to our people a knowledge of self. If a man does not have knowledge of himself and his position in society and the world, then he has little chance to relate to anything else.

6. We want all black men to be exempt from military service.

We believe that Black people, should not be forced to fight in the mifitary service to defend a racist government that does not protect us. We will not fight and kill other people of color in the world who, like black people, are being victimized by the white racist government of America. We will protect ourselves from the force and violence of the racist police and the racist military, by whatever means necessary.

We want an immediate end to POLICE BRUTALITY and MURDER of black people.

We believe we can end police brutality in our black community by organizing black self-defense groups that are dedicated to defending our black community from racist police oppression and brutality. The Second Amendment to the Constitution of the United States gives a right to bear arms. We therefore believe that all black people should arm themselves for self-defense.

8. We want freedom for all black men held in federal, state, county and city prisons and jails.

We believe that all black people should be released from the many jails and prisons because they have not received a fair and impartial trial.

9. We want all black people when brought to trial to be tried in court by a jury of their peer group or people from their black communities, as defined by the Constitution of the United States.

We believe that the courts should follow the United States Constitution so that black people will receive fair trials. The 14th Amendment of the U.S. Constitution gives a man'n right to be tried by his peer group. A peer is a person from a similar economic, social, religious, geographical, environmental, historical and racial background. To do this the court will be forced to select a jury from the black community from which the black defendant came. We have been, and are being tried by all-white juries that have no understanding of the "average reasoning man" of the black community.

10. We want land, bread, housing, education, clothing, justice and peace. And as our major political objective, a United Nations-supervised plebiscite to be held throughout the black colony in which only black colonial subjects will be allowed to participate, for the purpose of determining the will of black people as to their national destiny.

When, in the course of human events, it becomes necessary for one people to dissolve the political bands which have connected them with another, and to assume, among the powers of the earth, the separate and equal station to which the laws of nature and nature's God entitle them, a decent respect to the opinions of mankind requires that they should declare the causes which impel them to the separation.

We hold these truths to be self-evident, that all men are created equal; that they are endowed by their Creator with certain unalienable rights; that among these are life, liberty, and the pursuit of happiness. That, to secure these rights, governments are instituted among men, deriving their just powers from the consent of the governed; that, whenever any form of government becomes destructive of these ends, it is the right of the people to alter or to abolish it, and to institute a new government, laying its foundation on such principles, and organizing its powers in such form, as to them shall seem most likely to effect their safety and happiness. Prudence, indeed, will dictate that governments long established should not be changed for light and transient causes; and, accordingly, all experience hath shown, that mankind are more disposed to suffer, while evils are sufferable, than to right themselves by abolishing the forms to which they are accustomed. But, when a long train of abuses and usurpations, pursuing invariably the same object, evinces a design to reduce them under absolute despotism, it is their right, it is their duty, to throw off such government, and to provide new guards for their future security.
